

Critical Information for Students on the First Day

The Interactive TV website address: www.crc.losrios.edu/de . This site has phone numbers and other important information for students taking a TV Class.

1. The class is broadcast on Comcast Cable Sacramento, SureWest Cable Sacramento., and AT&T U-Verse (Ch. 99). Students can watch from home or attend the physical classroom do some of each. The class is also being video streamed on the Internet. Students can access the video stream by going to www.crc.losrios.edu/de. Classes are archived as well and available for later viewing as audio and video podcasts. Go the class Desire2Learn site for more information.
2. Students watching from home need to call in for attendance at the beginning of each class session. The number is (916) 691-7771. Instructions on how to participate in the class from your home or from another location will be given during the first class session (and repeated for a few sessions).
3. If you are going to watch only from home and come to the CRC campus only for tests, you will need to be placed on the mailing list. You can do this in two ways: (1) Go to www.crc.losrios.edu/de, click on the “**Mailing List**” link, and fill out the form or (2) call (916) 691-7149. Handout materials will only be mailed to those students that sign up for the mailing list. If you come to the campus more than once a week, do not sign up for the mailing list, because you will be able to get materials quicker in class or from the Media Center. **When registering for the mailing list by phone, you must talk to a live person. A message left on voice mail will not get you onto the mailing list !**
4. There is a three-day window to take exams for this class (2 working days before, in addition to the scheduled date). Students will receive a handout with information regarding the limited testing opportunities outside of class.
5. The class is being archived via streaming media and is podcasted. It can be accessed via your class Desire2Learn site. On campus, you can view these archives in the Library.
6. When you participate in the classroom by asking a question or offering a comment, you must push and hold down the button on the microphone on your desk. If you do not do this, the viewers at home will not hear the question.
